



God ... \Rightarrow There is only One true God. (Deut. 4:39, 1Tim. 2:5) \Rightarrow He created the world and all things in it. (Gen. 1:1, Heb. 11:3)

 \Rightarrow God showed his love to us by giving us His dearest treasure. (Rom. 8:32, 1Jo 4:10)

⇒ Jesus is true God. (John 10:30, Col. 2:9)
 ⇒ Jesus lived a perfect life and died an innocent death to pay for our sins (2Cor. 5:21,1Jo 1:7)

... that whoever believes

⇒ The belie ⇒ In the acco

⇒ The Holy Spirit creates faith in our hearts to believe in Jesus. (1Cor. 12:3, Rom. 5:5)
 ⇒ In this way, Jesus' perfect life and death are accounted to us. (Mk 16:16, Acts 16:30-31)

... in Him

 \Rightarrow Jesus is the only way to be saved. (ls. 43:11, Acts 4:12)

⇒ Jesus is the Messiah, the Savior from sin God promised in the Old Testament. (John 20:31)

... should not perish



⇒ Because of Jesus' death on our behalf, we don't have to die for our sins. (Rom. 5:1, 1Cor. 15:20-22)
 ⇒ God has done <u>everything</u> to pay for our sins. (John 19:30, Eph. 2:8-9)

...but have everlasting life.



⇒ We have been freed from death to inherit eternal life. (Jn 5:24, 1Jn 5:13)
 ⇒ We have been freed from sin to live in service to God. (Titus 2:14))

John 10:30 I and the Father are one.

- **Colossians 2:9** For in Him (Christ) dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily.
- 2 Corinthians 5:21 For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

- John 19:30 So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

Ephesians 2:8-9 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast. (Also Gal. 2:16)

- John 5:24 Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life.
 - **1 John 5:13** These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life. (Also Rom. 6:22, 1Jn 2:25)
 - Titus 2:14 [Christ] gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from ever lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works. (Also Rom. 3:28, 2Cor. 5:14-15, Gal. 2:20)

 Psalms 14:2-3 The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, and seek God. They are all gone aside, they are all together become filthy: there is none that does good; no, not one. (Also Rom. 3:23)

Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
2 Peter 3:9 The Lord...is not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance. (Also 1 Tim. 2:3-4, 1Jo 2:2)

Romans 8:32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?

1 John 4:10 In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
